Online Ticket Purchasing

The Alcatraz Cruises web site is the easiest way to get tickets to Alcatraz. As the official National Park Service concessioner for transportation to Alcatraz, we guarantee the lowest ticket prices available to the public. Our custom-designed database allows visitors to search for tickets for a specific day, the next available trip or tickets available in a five day window. Once a visitor has selected and purchased their tickets they can choose whether to print the tickets at home, thereby avoiding long lines, or pick them up at the will call booth at Alcatraz Landing.

Telephone Reservations

Location and Transportation

Alcatraz Landing is conveniently located at Pier 33 on the Embarcadero, between Chestnut and Bay Streets. It is one mile north of San Francisco's historic Ferry Building and less than a half a mile south of PIER 39. There are nine public parking lots located within a five block radius. Public transportation options include the famous San Francisco Cable Cars (closest stop is Hyde Street) and the historic F Line Street Cars (closest stop is Embarcadero at Bay).
